Walk-in visitors and new class members are welcome in all classes.

- FAITH IN EVERYDAY LIFE (Room 207) A group of singles and couples age 25ish and above, but all are welcome. A discussion-based class that values friendship. Come discuss a variety of contemporary topics related to living out the Christian faith, compassion, and social justice.
- FAITHFUL FAMILIES (B001A, off Youth Lounge) This class is made up of parents who are in the child-raising stage of life, and who enjoy discussionbased Bible studies related to living a faithful, Christ-centered life.
- CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP (Room 223) A multi-generational adult class that selects short-term studies which generate challenging discussion of Christian principles. Adam Hamilton will lead us in a 6 week DVD series called John: The Gospel of Light and Life. This special Lenten study follows the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus through the Gospel of John
- GROWING IN CHRIST (Room B004) A mixed class of single adults and couples of all ages that select short-term studies intended to challenge thinking and create fruitful conversation of Christian principles.
- GUYER CLASS (Room 123) A well-established group of elders in the church who study the United Methodist Quarterly Adult Bible Studies, which are designed as encouragement and instruction in living a life of faith.
