Walk-in visitors and new class members are welcome in all classes.

- **FAITH IN EVERYDAY LIFE** (Room 207) A group of singles and couples age 25ish and above, but all are welcome. A discussion-based class that values friendship. Come discuss a variety of contemporary topics related to living out the Christian faith, compassion, and social justice.
- **FAITHFUL FAMILIES** (B001A, off Youth Lounge) This class is made up of parents who are in the child-raising stage of life, and who enjoy discussionbased Bible studies related to living a faithful, Christ-centered life.
- CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP (Room 223) A multi-generational adult class that selects short-term studies which generate challenging discussion of Christian principles. Moses: In the Footsteps of the Reluctant Prophet by Adam Hamilton. Join us as we follow the footsteps of Moses, a reluctant prophet, who blazed a trail of faith. We will explore the sites of Moses' life from the Nile River to the Red Sea, from Mt. Sinai to the desert wilderness.
- GROWING IN CHRIST (Room B004) A mixed class of single adults and couples of all ages that select short-term studies intended to challenge thinking and create fruitful conversation of Christian principles.
- GUYER CLASS (Room 123) A well-established group of elders in the church who study the United Methodist Quarterly Adult Bible Studies, which are designed as encouragement and instruction in living a life of faith.
