### **& Adult Sunday School &**

Walk-in visitors and new class members are welcome in all classes.

- FAITH IN EVERYDAY LIFE (Room 207) A group of singles and couples age 25ish and above, but all are welcome. A discussion-based class that values friendship, sometimes getting together outside of class. Come discuss a variety of contemporary topics related to living out the Christian faith, compassion, and social justice.

- GUYER CLASS (Room 123) A well-established group of elders in the church who study the United Methodist Quarterly Adult Bible Studies, which are designed as encouragement and instruction in living a life of faith.
- HELPING HANDS CLASS (Room 105 in office wing) A group of
  active seniors who focus on studies designed as encouragement and
  instruction on living a life of faith. Interactive studies and discussions are
  led by several class members. Also, class members enjoy many Christian
  social activities together.


### **& Children's Sunday School**
