

- Classes for babies and toddlers are located on the first floor of the Children's Department. Check in with the greeter who will guide you to your child's room.

- **Middle School:** 6th-8th grade students meet in B003 for *Deep Discipleship*. Join us as we seek to grow deep roots of faith as we grow into more faithful followers of Jesus Christ.
- High school: 9th-12th grade students meet in the youth lounge for *Faith in Action: learn, lead, teach, and serve.*

## & Adult Sunday School &

#### Walk-in visitors and new class members are welcome in all classes.

- **GROWING IN CHRIST** (Room B004) An intergenerational class designed for adults of all ages who would like to learn and grow together. Focus on short-term studies which challenge thinking and create fruitful conversation of Christian principles. Currently studying "God Is" focused on the names/character of God.
- **FAITH IN EVERYDAY LIFE** (Room 207) A group of singles and couples age 25ish and above, but all are welcome. A discussion-based class that values friendship. Come discuss a variety of contemporary topics related to living out the Christian faith, compassion, and social justice.
- **FAITHFUL FAMILIES (B001A)** This class is made up of parents who are in the child-raising stage of life, and who enjoy discussion-based Bible studies related to living a faithful, Christ-centered life.
- **CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP** (Room 223) A multi-generational adult class that selects short-term studies which generate challenging discussion of Christian principles. Come join us for a special 5 part Lenten DVD series from Max Lucado entitled "He Chose The Nails". The cross is rich with God's gifts of grace, and as we unwrap them, we will hear him whisper, "I did it just for you."
- *HELPING HANDS CLASS* (Room 105) A group of active seniors who focus on studies designed as encouragement and instruction on living a life of faith. Interactive studies and discussions are led by several class members. Also, class members enjoy many Christian social activities together.
- *GUYER CLASS* (Room 123) A well-established group of elders in the church who study together using the United Methodist Quarterly Adult Bible Study lessons. Each lesson is focused on scripture, and encourages participants to live a faith-filled life.
- Short-Term, Topical Bible Studies Designed for people of all ages who desire to learn and grow together as they study specific topics:
  - *"Short Stories by Jesus"* by Amy-Jill Levine. Learn how original audiences understood Jesus' parables, and discover how those same lessons challenge us today. Led by Lisa Aronson in room B002. Runs through April 14.
  - *"Resolving Everyday Conflict"* by Peacemaker Ministries. Learn what the Bible says about conflict, and discover how to grow in your personal relationships. Facilitated by John Aronson/Barry Eaton in room B006. Runs through April 28.


