Romans 8: 35-39



"Will the love of God hold me now?"

1. Yes, because ______ and _____!

Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will hardship, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? (verse 35)

Five times I have received from the Jews the forty lashes minus one. Three times I was beaten with rods. Once I received a stoning. Three times I was shipwrecked; for a night and a day I was adrift at sea; on frequent journeys, in danger from rivers, danger from bandits, danger from my own people, danger from Gentiles, danger in the city, danger in the wilderness, danger at sea, danger from false brothers and sisters; in toil and hardship, through many a sleepless night, hungry and thirsty, often without food, cold and naked. (2 Corinthians 11:24-27)

As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all day long; we are accounted as sheep to be slaughtered." (verse 36)

No, in all these things we are more than conquerors **through him** who loved us. (verse 37)

As they left the council, they rejoiced that they were considered worthy to suffer dishonor for the sake of the name. (Acts 5:41)

3. Yes, because God's love _____!

For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor rulers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord. (verses 38-39)
