



But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for see—I am bringing you good news of great joy for all the people: to you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is the Messiah, the Lord. (verses 10-11)

1. The Good News moves us	
T. THE GOOD NEWS HOVES US	

When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let us go now to Bethlehem and see this thing that has taken place, which the Lord has made known to us." So **they went with haste** and found Mary and Joseph, and the child lying in the manger. (verses 15-16)



2. The Good News moves us

When they saw this, **they made known what had been told them** about this child; and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds told them. (verses 17-18)



3. The Good News moves us _____

The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, as it had been told them. (verse 20)


