Mark 1: 29-39




"Everyone is distracted all the time." (Justin Rosenstein, Facebook engineer)

Three things Jesus did to stay focused in a world of distractions:

1. Jesus had a _____ to pray.

In the morning, while it was still very dark, he got up and went out to a deserted place, and there he prayed. (verse 35)

In the morning, LORD, you hear my voice; in the morning I lay my requests before you and wait expectantly. (Psalm 5:3 NIV)



But I, O LORD, cry out to you; in the morning my prayer comes before you. (Psalm 88:13)

2. Jesus had a _____ to pray.

In the morning, while it was still very dark, he got up **and went out to a deserted place**, and there he prayed. (verse 35)


But Jesus often withdrew to lonely places and prayed. (Luke 5:16 NIV)
