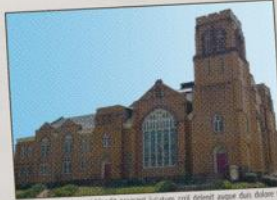

# Good News: Jesus Isn't Afraid of Your Mess

Mark 1: 40-45

---



The Joy of Watching Other People Clean

1. Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ in our mess.

*Just then there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit, and he cried out, "What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are, the Holy One of God." **But Jesus rebuked him**, saying, "Be silent, and come out of him!" And the unclean spirit, convulsing him and crying with a loud voice, came out of him. (Mark 1:23-26)*

*Now Simon's mother-in-law was in bed with a fever, and they told him about her at once. **He came and took her by the hand and lifted her up**. Then the fever left her, and she began to serve them. (Mark 1:30-31)*

*A leper came to him begging him, and kneeling he said to him, "If you choose, you can make me clean." **Moved with pity**, Jesus stretched out his hand and touched him, and said to him, "I do choose. Be made clean!" Immediately the leprosy left him, and he was made clean. (Mark 1:40-42)*

*After sternly warning him he sent him away at once, saying to him, “See that you say nothing to anyone; but go, show yourself to the priest, and offer for your cleansing what Moses commanded, as a testimony to them.” But he went out and began to proclaim it freely, and to spread the word, **so that Jesus could no longer go into a town openly, but stayed out in the country; and people came to him from every quarter.** (Mark 1:43-45)*

*But he was wounded for our transgressions, crushed for our iniquities; upon him was **the punishment that made us whole, and by his bruises we are healed.** (Isaiah 53:5)*
