

## Seven Words: "Behold Your Son...Behold Your Mother" John 19:25-27



"Jesus, through the words he speaks to his mother and friend, creates the church, and that church becomes family to one another!" (Robb, <u>Seven Words</u> p.68)

Meanwhile, standing near the cross of Jesus were his mother, and his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene. (verse 25)

The Role of Women in Jesus' Ministry

- Women financially supported Jesus and his disciples (Luke 8:1-3)
- A woman was the first missionary to the Samaritans (John 4:28-29)
- A woman anointed Jesus with oil as preparation for his burial (Matthew 26:6-13)
- Women first came to the tomb Easter morning (Mark 16:1-8)
- A woman became the first to proclaim the Resurrection (John 20:11-18)

<sup>26</sup> You are all God's children through faith in Christ Jesus. <sup>27</sup> All of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. <sup>28</sup> There is neither Jew nor Greek; there is neither slave nor free; nor is there male and female, **for you are all one in Christ Jesus**. (Galatians 3:26-28)


