

# All Day Every Day: "Planning for Tomorrow by Surrendering Today"

# L**IF**E

Planning for tomorrow begins with surrendering today.

Look here, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we are going to a certain town and will stay there a year. We will do business there and make a profit." (James 4:13 NLT)

- Time ("Today or tomorrow...")
- Location ("We will go to a certain town...")
- Itinerary ("Spend a year there, carry on business...")
- Goal ("And make money.")
- GOD (!!!)

Planning for tomorrow begins with surrendering today.

How do you know what your life will be like tomorrow? Your life is like the morning fog—it's here a little while, then it's gone. (James 4:14 NLT)

*My days are like a shadow soon gone. I'm dried up like dead grass.* (Psalm 102:11 CEB)

Instead, you ought to say, "If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that." (James 4:15 NIV)

Otherwise you are boasting about your own pretentious plans, and all such boasting is evil. Remember, it is sin to know what you ought to do and then not do it. (James 4:16-17 NLT)

Then he told them a parable: "A certain rich man's land produced a bountiful crop. He said to himself, What will I do? I have no place to store my harvest! Then he thought, Here's what I'll do. I'll tear down my barns and build bigger ones. That's where I'll store all my grain and goods. I'll say to myself, You have stored up plenty of goods, enough for several years. Take it easy! Eat, drink, and enjoy yourself. But God said to him, 'Fool, tonight you will die. Now who will get the things you have prepared for yourself?' This is the way it will be for those who hoard things for themselves and aren't rich toward God." (Luke 12:16-21 CEB)

Because schools are continuing to adjust plans according to circumstances surrounding Covid, let's focus our prayers on this attribute - *God, our <u>Master Planner</u>!* 

- 1. **Praise**—Praise God for **who He is**, His attribute as our Master Planner, the One who has the perfect plan, the One who plans our day-to-day steps. *Suggested scripture: Jeremiah 29:11, Psalm 32:8, Psalm 33:11, 2 Peter 3:9*
