In this New Year...

1. I can **seek** the King or not.

Jesus was born in Bethlehem in Judea, during the reign of King Herod. About that time some wise men from eastern lands arrived in Jerusalem, asking, “Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star as it rose, and we have come to worship him.” King Herod was deeply disturbed when he heard this, as was everyone in Jerusalem.

(Matthew 2:1-3 NLT)

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16 KJV)

Herod seeks **only himself**. The wise men seek **Jesus**.

2. I can **worship** the King or not.

Then Herod called for a private meeting with the wise men, and he learned from them the time when the star first appeared. Then he told them, “Go to Bethlehem and search carefully for the child. And when you find him, come back and tell me so that I can go and worship him, too!”

After this interview the wise men went their way. And the star they had seen in the east guided them to Bethlehem. It went ahead of them and stopped over the place where the child was. When they saw the star, they were filled with joy!

They entered the house and saw the child with his mother, Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him. Then they opened their treasure chests and gave him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. (Matthew 2:7-11 NLT)

“The God I didn’t believe in believed in me!”

3. I can **follow** the King or not.

When it was time to leave, they returned to their own country by another route, for God had warned them in a dream not to return to Herod. After the wise men were gone, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream. “Get up! Flee to Egypt with the child and his mother,” the angel said. “Stay there until I tell you to return, because Herod is going to search for the child to kill him.” (Matthew 2:12-13 NLT)

For we have observed his star at its rising and have come to pay him homage.*" They see something of significance in the baby in Bethlehem, even when many of those closest don't see it. Like the wise men, we who have seen the light of Christ are called to reflect it so that others see Christ through our loving presence. As we begin 2022, you are invited to journey with us through our daily Bible readings and Sunday worship services.
