# "It Wouldn't Be Christmas Without.... The Mess"

1. Jesus was born for people with messy families.

Abraham was the father of Isaac. Isaac was the father of Jacob. Jacob was the father of Judah and his brothers. Judah was the father of Perez and Zerah, whose mother was Tamar... (Matthew 1:2-3a CEB)

2. Jesus was born for people hurt by messy disappointments.

Both of them were righteous before God, living blamelessly according to all the commandments and regulations of the Lord. But they had no children, because Elizabeth was barren, and both were getting on in years.

(Luke 1:6-7)

3. Jesus was born for people struggling with messy choices.

Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been engaged to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. Her husband Joseph, being a righteous man and unwilling to expose her to public disgrace, planned to dismiss her quietly. (Matthew 1:18-19)

Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?" (Luke 1:34)

4. Jesus was born for people troubled by messy circumstances.

And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in bands of cloth and laid him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn. (Luke 2:7)

Now after they had left, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, "Get up, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt, and remain there until I tell you; for Herod is about to search for the child, to destroy him." (Matthew 2:13)

5. God stepped into our mess to save us and set us free.
