

“You Are the Body: God’s Beloved”

Now ***you are the body*** of Christ and individually members of it. (1 Corinthians 12:27)

“What does it look like for ***you*** to be the body of Christ ***now?***”

1. Wade into the water with ***all*** the people.

2. Hold on to God in ***prayer***.

bodily form like a dove. (Luke 3:21b-22a)
