"By Your Spirit make us **one** with Christ, **one** with each other, and **one** in ministry to all the world, until Christ comes in final victory and we feast at his heavenly banquet."

1. You are One with Christ

For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and we were all made to drink of one Spirit. (1 Corinthians 12:12-13)

On that day you will know that I am in my Father, you are in me, and I am in you. (John 14:20)

2. You are One with each other

If the whole body were an eye, where would the hearing be? If the whole body were hearing, where would the sense of smell be? (1 Corinthians 12:17)



But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose. If all were a single member, where would the body be? As it is, there are **many** members, yet **one** body. (1 Corinthians 12:18-20)

But God has so arranged the body, giving the greater honor to the inferior member, that there may be no dissension within the body, but the members may have **the same care for one another.** If one member suffers, all suffer together with it; if one member is honored, all rejoice together with it. (1 Corinthians 12:24b-26)

3. You are **One** in ministry to all the world

Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it. And God has appointed in the church first apostles, second prophets, third teachers; then deeds of power, then gifts of healing, forms of assistance, forms of leadership, various kinds of tongues... (1 Corinthians 12:27-28)
