

"You are the Body: Love Is the Way"



"And I'm going to show you an even better way." (1 Corinthians 12:31b)

1. Love is essential.

If I speak in tongues of human beings and of angels **but I don't have love**, I'm a clanging gong or a clashing cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy and I know all the mysteries and everything else, and if I have such complete faith that I can move mountains **but I don't have love**, I'm nothing. If I give away everything that I have and hand over my own body to feel good about what I've done **but I don't have love**, I receive no benefit whatsoever (verses 1-3)

"You are the salt of the earth. But if salt loses its saltiness, how will it become salty again? It's **good for nothing** except to be thrown away and trampled under people's feet.

(Matthew 5:13)

2. Love is *effective*.

Love is patient, love is kind, it isn't jealous, it doesn't brag, it isn't arrogant, it isn't rude, it doesn't seek its own advantage, it isn't irritable, it doesn't keep a record of complaints, it isn't happy with injustice, but it is happy with the truth. Love puts up with all things, trusts in all things, hopes for all things, endures all things. Love never fails. (verses 4-8a)

"Make no mistake. The love Paul is talking about here is not passive and fluffy. This kind of love is an up at dawn, feet on the ground, tools in hand, working kind of love. It builds communities. It nurtures positive social interactions, and not just social networks (which many of us have come to prefer). Paul's declaration of love unifies."

Everything should be done in love. (1 Corinthians 16:14)

3. Love is eternal.

As for prophecies, they will be brought to an end. As for tongues, they will stop. As for knowledge, it will be brought to an end. We know in part and we prophesy in part; but when the perfect comes, what is partial will be brought to an end. (verses 8b-10)

When I was **a child**, I used to speak like a child, reason like a child, think like a child. But now that I have become a man, I've put an end to childish things. (verse 11)

Now we see a reflection in **a mirror**; then we will see face-to-face. Now I know partially, but then I will know completely in the same way that I have been completely known. (verse 12)

4. Before love is something you do it has to be Someone you know.

This is **how we know love**: Jesus laid down his life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters. (1 John 3:16)
