"You are the Body: Seeing the Glory"

"Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it." (1 Corinthians 12:27)

"As we gaze on your kingly brightness, So our faces display your likeness; Ever changing from glory to glory, Mirrored here let our lives tell your story. Shine on me, shine on me." ("Shine, Jesus, Shine," Graham Kendrick)

1. We see the glory of Jesus in prayer.

Now about eight days after these sayings Jesus took with him Peter and John and James, and went up on the mountain to pray. And while he was praying, the appearance of his face changed, and his clothes became dazzling white. (Luke 9:28-29)

"If you establish a prayer routine, your life will be anything but routine. You will go places, do things, and meet people you have no business going to, doing, or meeting. You don't need to seek opportunity. All you have to do is seek God. And if you seek God, opportunity will seek you." (Mark Batterson, <u>Draw the Circle</u>, p. 19)

2. We see the glory of Jesus in Scripture.

Suddenly they saw two men, **Moses and Elijah**, talking to him. They appeared in glory and were speaking of his departure, which he was about to accomplish at Jerusalem. (Luke 9:30-31)

Moses came down from Mount Sinai. As he came down from the mountain with the two tablets of the covenant in his hand, Moses did not know that the skin of his face shone because **he had been talking with God.** (Exodus 34:29)

He said, "Go out and stand on the mountain before the LORD, for the LORD is about to pass by." Now there was a great wind, so strong that it was splitting mountains and breaking rocks in pieces before the LORD, but the LORD was not in the wind; and after the wind an earthquake, but the LORD was not in the earthquake; and after the earthquake a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire; and after the fire a sound of sheer silence. (1 Kings 19:11-12)

3. We see the glory of Jesus in the midst of everyday life.

Now Peter and his companions were weighed down with sleep; but **since they had stayed awake**, they saw his glory and the two men who stood with him. (Luke 9:32)

4. We see the glory of Jesus so that we may reflect it to others.

Just as they were leaving him, Peter said to Jesus, "Master, it is good for us to be here; let us make three dwellings, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah"—not knowing what he said. While he was saying this, a cloud came and overshadowed them; and they were terrified as they entered the cloud.

Then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my Son, my Chosen; **listen to him!**" When the voice had spoken, Jesus was found alone. And they kept silent and in those days told no one any of the things they had seen. (Luke 9:33-36)
