

Our Lenten Challenge: Pray Every Day for 40 Days



Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need. (Hebrews 4:16)

"The true purpose of prayer is to get into God's presence so that He can outline his agenda for us." (<u>Draw the Circle</u>, page 11)

1. Find **a time** to pray.

If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, pray, seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land. (2 Chronicles 7:14)

2. Find a place to pray.
