“Dream Big”

1. Drawing prayer circles often looks like **an exercise in foolishness.**

Now Jericho was shut up inside and out because of the Israelites; no one came out and no one went in. (Joshua 6:1)

2. Drawing prayer circles expresses that **nothing is too big and nothing is too small for God.**

The LORD said to Joshua, “See, I have handed Jericho over to you, along with its king and soldiers.” (Joshua 6:2)

“Two things about God I know to be true are that God is bigger than big and God is closer than close. And those two realities shape our prayer life.” (Mark Batterson)

Transcendence – God is bigger than big!

*For my thoughts are not your thoughts,
nor are your ways my ways, says the LORD.
For as the heavens are higher than the earth,
so are my ways higher than your ways
and my thoughts than your thoughts. (Isaiah 55:8-9)*

Immanence – God is closer than close!

*But Zion said, “The LORD has forsaken me,
my Lord has forgotten me.”
Can a woman forget her nursing child,
or show no compassion for the child of her womb?
Even these may forget,
yet I will not forget you.
See, I have inscribed you on the palms of my hands; (Isaiah 49:14-16a)*

3. Drawing prayer circles **puts on waders.**

You shall march around the city, all the warriors circling the city once. Thus you shall do for six days, with seven priests bearing seven trumpets of rams' horns before the ark. On the seventh day you shall march around the city seven times, the priests blowing the trumpets. (Joshua 6:3-4)

4. Drawing prayer circles gives us a **God's eye view**.

When they make a long blast with the ram's horn, as soon as you hear the sound of the trumpet, then all the people shall shout with a great shout; and the wall of the city will fall down flat, and all the people shall charge straight ahead." (Joshua 6:5)

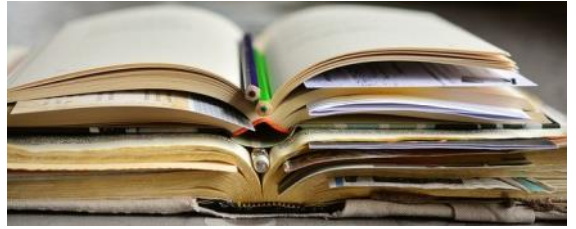
5. Drawing prayer circles makes **crazy the new normal**.
