

Clothed with Christ

²⁷ As many of you as were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.

Galatians 3:27 (NRSV)

You Are All God's Children Through Faith

²³ Now before **faith** came, we were imprisoned and guarded under the law until **faith** would be revealed. ²⁴ Therefore the law was our **disciplinarian** until Christ came, so that we might be reckoned as righteous [a] by **faith**. ²⁵ But now that **faith** has come, we are no longer subject to a **disciplinarian**, ²⁶ for in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through **faith**.

Galatians 3:23-26 (NRSV)

Abraham didn't focus on his own impotence and say, "It's hopeless. This hundred-year-old body could never father a child." Nor did he survey Sarah's decades of in fertility and give up. He didn't tiptoe around God's promise asking cautiously skeptical questions.

He plunged into the promise and came up strong, ready for God, sure that God would make good on what he had said. That's why it is said, "Abraham was declared fit before God by trusting God to set him right."

But it's not just Abraham; it's also us!The same thing gets said about us when we embrace andbelieve the One who brought Jesus to life when the conditions were equally hopeless.Thesacrificed Jesus made us fit for God, set us right with God.Romans 4:19-25 (The Message)




