

I Corinthians 12:4-11

This is the day that the LORD has made; let US rejoice and be glad in it. Psalm 118:24

How to Rejoice and Be Glad in This Day

1. See this day as a gift from God.

Today is the day for the ride of our lives, when a confetti of color will fill the sky! Plenty of pink, a bounty of blue, and orange, green, and yellow too!

Now there are **varieties of gifts** but the same Spirit, ⁵ and there are **varieties of services** but the same Lord, ⁶ and there are **varieties of activities**, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone. I Corinthians 12:4-6

2. Remember that you have so much to give.
