

"Antlers Forever!" by Frances Bloxam Matthew 6:25-34

"O dear!" cried poor Orville, "A terrible thing!
I've worked on these antlers since early spring!

Now winter is coming, and what shall I do
Without my fine antlers? Oh, boo hoo hoo hoooo!"

"And why do you worry...?"

Matthew 6:28a

1. To overcome worry, start with God, not your circumstances.

"It's Vitamin M! That's the thing I must lack.

You get that from beezels, and those grow out back.

I really hate beezels-but losing your antlers is serious stuff!"

So Orville at beezels, and beezels galore, until he was full, then he burped and ate more!

With Owl holding on, Orville started to spin.

There was screeching and flapping-a terrible din!

When finally they quit, Orville crashed in a heap,

And Owl was too tired to make even a peep...

They waited a minute, till all the dust cleared, And then Orville saw it was just as he feared... A big voice then called out, "Come, come, my sad fellow!

I was miles away, but I heard every bellow.
