## **TEACHING NOTES**

#### "Be Kind to One Another" Luke 10:25-37

#### Kindness is **counter-cultural**.

<sup>31</sup>Put away from you all bitterness and wrath and anger and wrangling and slander, togetherwith all malice. <sup>32</sup>Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ has forgiven you. Ephesians 4:31-32

Kindness is love in action.

*Let all that you do be done in love.* I Corinthians 16:14

Attitudes Toward Others

1. Avoidance: I can keep my distance.

<sup>30</sup>Jesus answered, "There was once a man who was going down f rom Jerusalem to Jerichowhen robbers attacked him, stripped him, and beat him up, leaving him half dead. <sup>31</sup>It so happened that a priest was going down that road; but when he saw the man, he walked on by on the other side. Luke 10:30-31 (Good News)

#### 2. Apathy: I can be curious, but not caring.

<sup>32</sup>In the same way a Levite also came there, went over and looked at the man, and thenwalked on by on the other side. Luke 10:32 (Good News) 3. Love in Action: I can **show kindness**.

<sup>33</sup>But a Samaritan who was traveling that way came upon the man, and when he saw him, his heart was filled with pity. Luke 10:33 (Good News)

<sup>32</sup>Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ has forgiven you. Ephesians 4:32

4. How do you develop the spiritual fruit of kindness?

- Ask God to help you see people the way God sees them.
- Practice the art of listening.
- When you see a need, respond to it.
