"Bear One Another's Burdens" Galatians 6:1-10

⁹ So **let us not grow weary** in doing what is right, for we will reap at harvest time, if we do not give up. Galatians 6:9

> Bear One Another's Burdens... You are family in Christ.

My **brothers and sisters**, if anyone is detected in a transgression, you who have received the Spirit should restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness. Take care that you yourselves are not tempted.² **Bear one another's burdens**, and in this way you will fulfill[a] the law of Christ. Galatians 6:1-2

For you were called to freedom, **brothers and sisters**, only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for self-indulgence,[a] but through love **become en-slaved to one another**. ¹⁴ For the whole law is summed up in a single commandment, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." Galatians 5:13-15

> Bear One Another's Burdens... You are gifted and called.

³ For if those who are nothing think they are something, they deceive themselves. ⁴ All must test their own work; then that work, rather than their neighbor's work, will become a cause for pride. ⁵ **For all must carry their own loads**.
