Keep Your Heart Pure

<sup>19</sup> "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust[a] consume and where thieves break in and steal, <sup>20</sup> but store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust[b] consumes and where thieves do not break in and steal. <sup>21</sup> **For where your treasure is,** 

there your heart will be also.

Matthew 6:19-21
