TEACHING NOTES

"And they will call him, Emmanuel."

Matthew 1:23

One way we experience joy is in the gift of presence. Being present for someone is one of the best presents we can give. It's one that reflects what God gifted us: Jesus our Emmanuel, which means "God with us."

Cindy-Lou Who helped the Grinch experience joy because she offered presence: the chance for the Grinch to be surrounded by love and acceptance.

Who is God laying on your heart and mind that you can be present for this Christmas?

"When Joseph woke up, he did just as the angel from God commanded and took Mary as his wife."

Matthew 1:24

Joseph demonstrates that joy arises when we look beyond our own needs and to the needs of others. Joseph could have dismissed Mary and the baby, but he didn't. He responded to the need he saw and the need God called him to.

The greatest hurdle the Grinch faced in experiencing joy was his inability to look beyond himself and to the needs of others.

Are you feeling more Joseph-like or Grinch-like this Christmas and why? In what ways can you foster joy by helping or doing something for another?

For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and set down at the right hand of the father.

Hebrews 12:2

We don't need perfect circumstances to experience joy. Jesus faced crucifixion, shame, ridicule, and betrayal. Yet, He knew joy.

The Grinch's past was not going to change and he was still going to be an oddly colored Who. Still, he came to know joy. Cindy-Lou Who's mom was stretched thin being a single parent, and yet she chose joy.

What hinders your joy? How does the Christmas story encourage you to choose joy despite your past, present or future challenges?
