

## **TEACHING NOTES**

## "When Life Changes" Matthew 17:1-9

From that time on, Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and undergo great suffering at the hands of the elders and chief priests and scribes and be killed and on the third day be raised.

Matthew 16:21

<sup>22</sup>As they were gathering in Galilee, Jesus said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into human hands, <sup>23</sup>and they will kill him, and on the third day he will be raised." And they were greatly distressed.

Matthew 17:22-23

#### "Listen to Him!"

While he was still speaking, suddenly a bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from the cloud said, "This is my Son, the Beloved; with him I am well pleased; **listen to him**!"

#### "Get Up"

<sup>6</sup> When the disciples heard this, they fell to the ground and were overcome by fear. <sup>7</sup> But Jesus came and touched them, saying, "**Get up** and do not be afraid."

Matthew 17:6-7

- Jesus heals the paralytic, telling him, "**Stand up**." (Matthew 9:6-7)
- Jesus takes the hand of the dead daughter of the synagogue leader, "**and the girl got up**." (Matthew 9:25)
- Jesus instructs the twelve, "Raise the dead." (Matthew 10:8)
- Jesus foretells his own **resurrection**. (Matthew 16:21)
- The angel tells the women who come to the tomb, "He is not here for **he has been raised** as he said." (Matthew 28:6)
