

## "Capernaum: Following Jesus When You Doubt"

Mark 5:21-43

"Do you think he can?"

"Do you think he cares?"

"Do you think he'll come?"

1. Jesus can help.

<sup>22</sup> Then one of the leaders of the synagogue, named Jairus, came and, when he saw him, **fell at his feet** <sup>23</sup> **and pleaded with him repeatedly**, "My little daughter is at the point of death. Come and lay your hands on her, so that she may be made well and live."

Mark 5:22-23

<sup>27</sup> She had heard about Jesus and **came up behind him in the crowd and touched his cloak**, <sup>28</sup> for she said, "If I but touch his cloak, I will be made well." <sup>29</sup> Immediately her flow of blood stopped, and she felt in her body that she was healed of her disease.
