

TEACHING NOTES

"Garden Moments: Following Jesus When You Are Afraid" Mark 14:32-42



1. Jesus experienced fear.

³²They went to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to his disciples, "Sit here while I pray." ³³He took with him Peter and James and John and began to be distressed and agitated. ³⁴And he said to them, "My soul is deeply grieved, even to death; remain here, and keep awake."

Mark 14:32-34

2. Jesus took his fears to God in prayer.

He said, "Abba, Father, for you all things are possible; remove this cup from me, yet not what I want but what you want."

Mark 14:36

- Jesus' prayer was personal: Abba, Father
 - ♦ "Jesus' garden prayer is a child's prayer." Max Lucado
- Jesus' prayer was trusting: for you all things are possible
- Jesus' prayer was specific: remove this cup from me
 - ♦ "Be specific about your fears. Identify what 'this cup' is and talk to God about it. Putting your worries into words disrobes them. They look silly standing there naked." – Max Lucado
- Jesus' prayer was surrendered: yet not what I want but what you want.

1"Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe[a] in God; believe also in me. ²In my Father's house there are many dwelling places. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? ³And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, so that where I am, there you may be also.

John 14:1-3

3. Jesus shared his fears with a trusted circle of friends.

"The next time you find yourself facing a worst-case moment, do this. Verbalize your angst to a trusted circle of God-seekers. This is an essential step. Find your version of Peter, James, and John. The big deal (and good news) is this: you needn't live alone with your fear." – Max Lucado

Questions for Reflection:

- 1. What role does fear play in your life?
- 2. How does it make you feel knowing that Jesus experienced fear?
- 3. What difference has it made for you to take your fears to God in prayer?
- 4. How do Jesus' words, "I go to prepare a place for you" help you with your fears?
- 5. Who are your Peter, James, and John?
