Mount of the Beatitudes Following Jesus When You Worry

Matthew 6:25-34

"What does all this anxiety mean? All this fear? Trepidation? Restlessness? Insecurity? What does it mean? Simply this: you are a human being." – Max Lucado

Worry is the way we respond **mentally** to uncertainty.

"You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind and your neighbor as yourself."
