TEACHING NOTES

"Sea of Galilee: Following Jesus in Your Storms" Matthew 14:22-33

"The lake became a popcorn popper, lifting their boat, spinning it around, plopping it down." – Max Lucado

1. Even when we can't see Jesus, Jesus sees us.

And early in the morning he came walking toward them on the sea. Matthew 14:25

> "I will never leave you or forsake you." Hebrews 13:5b

"Jesus doesn't always show up the way we think he will. He doesn't always show up when we think he will (remember the disciples were battling the storm for hours before Jesus appeared). And he doesn't always look the way we think he will look. But that doesn't mean he doesn't come. It just means we have to be looking for him." – Max Lucado

2. Jesus is greater than our storms.

"Courage! I am! Don't be afraid!" Matthew 14:27 (Bruner translation) Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid.

John 14:27
