

TEACHING NOTES

"Garden Tomb: Following Jesus When You Need Hope" Matthew 28:1-10

Easter Sunday



Signs that Hope is Gone:

Mary and Mary watch as Jesus' body is buried. (27:61) Chief priests and Pharisees go to Pilate. (27:62) Tomb is sealed and guard is posted. (27:66)

Signs that Hope is Breaking Through:

The earth quakes. (28:2)

An angel descends from heaven, rolls the stone away, and sits on it. (28:2-3)

Guards shake and become like dead men. (28:4)

The angel speaks Do not be afraid. (28:5)

"Come, see the place where he lay." (28:6)

Then go quickly and tell his disciples... (28:7)

Mary and Mary run to tell his disciples! (28:8)

1. God wants to heal our past.

After the Sabbath, as the first day of the week was dawning, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to see the tomb. Matthew 28:1

2. God wants to engage us in the present.

Suddenly Jesus met them and said, "Greetings!" And they came to him, took hold of his feet, and worshiped him.

Matthew 28:9

3. God wants us to dream with him about the future.

Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid; go and tell my brothers and sisters to go to Galilee; there they will see me."

Matthew 28:10

- 1. What forces are at work today to destroy hope?
- 2. What signs do you see that hope abounds?
- 3. What hurts from the past do you need to bring to God?
- 4. Where do you see God at work today?
- 5. What is God's dream for the future? How is God calling you to be part of it?
