Jesus Believes in You

Matthew 14:22-33

I. Jesus sent the disciples into the storm.

Immediately he made the disciples get into the boat and go on ahead to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. Matthew 14:22

II. Faith leads you through the difficulty, not around it.

²⁴but by this time the boat, battered by the waves, was far from the land, for the wind was against them.
²⁵And early in the morning he came walking toward them on the sea.
Matthew 14:24-25


