#### "I Believe in the Holy Spirit"

John 14:15-21, 25-27

"If you love me, you will keep my commandments."

John 14:15

<sup>16</sup> "And I will ask the Father, and he will give you **another Advocate**, to be with you forever. <sup>17</sup> This is **the Spirit of truth**, whom the world cannot receive because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him because he abides with you, and he will be in you."

John 14:16-17

1. The Holy Spirit gifts us for humble acts of service.

<sup>14</sup> "So if I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. <sup>15</sup> For I have set you an example, that you also should do as I have done to you."

John 13:14-15

<sup>4</sup>Now there are **varieties** of gifts but **the same** Spirit, <sup>5</sup> and there are **varieties** of services but **the same** Lord, <sup>6</sup> and there are **varieties** of activities, but it is **the same** God who activates all of them in everyone. <sup>7</sup> To **each** is given the manifestation of the Spirit for **the common good**.
