

"I Believe in the Forgiveness of Sins"

1. Who needs forgiveness?

Sin = "to miss the mark"

²² By contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against such things.

Galatians 5:22-23

Most merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done, and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent. – UM Hymnal #890

2. Will God forgive my sins?

"She will bear a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." Matthew 1:21 ²⁶ While they were eating, Jesus took a loaf of bread, and after blessing it he broke it, gave it to the disciples, and said, "Take, eat; this is my body."²⁷ Then he took a cup, and after giving thanks he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you, ²⁸ for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins." Matthew 26:26-28

To forgive = to release

⁹ He will not always accuse, nor will he keep his anger forever.
¹⁰ He does not deal with us according to our sins nor repay us according to our iniquities.
¹¹ For as the heavens are high above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him;
¹² as far as the east is from the west, so far he removes our transgressions from us. Psalm 103:9-12

3. Must I forgive others?

¹⁴ "For if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you, ¹⁵ but if you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses." Matthew 6:14-15
