TEACHING NOTES

"The Word Collector"

By Peter H. Reynolds First in the Series: "Story Time: Echoes of Faith"

Jerome collected words.

1. Store up God's Word in your heart.

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. Psalm 119:105

He collected words he heard. Certain words caught his attention.

He collected words he saw. Certain words jumped out at him.

He collected words he read. Certain words popped off the page

There were words he did not know the meaning of at first, but they were marvelous to say.

¹⁶ All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and fortraining in righteousness, ¹⁷ so that the person of God may be proficient, equipped for every good work. 2 Timothy 3:16-17

2. Sharing God's Word even in simple ways can make a powerful impact.

The more words he knew the more clearly he could share with the world what he was thinking, feeling, and dreaming.

3. Joy is found in scattering the good seed of God's Word everywhere.

He smiled as he emptied his collection of words into the wind.

He saw children in the valley below... ...scurrying about collecting words from the breeze.

Jerome had no words to describe how happy that made him.

- 1. Do you have a "life verse" that you return to often? Are there other words from Scripture that are especially meaningful to you?
- 2. Where do you stop, look, and listen as you collect God's Word?
- 3. What challenges or obstacles make it difficult to collect God's Word?
- 4. When have you been surprised or delighted by something you've discovered in God's Word?
- 5. In your day to day life, how do you share God's Word with others?

Mission Central is a Mechanicsburg-based nonprofiit dedicated to connecting God's resources with human need, including through disaster relief efforts. Our goal is to provide supplies and assemble at least 75 CARE Kits for Mission Central. We invite you to join us in the joy of serving by donating items and helping us assemble the kits. All items must be new. Do not wash any of the items (they will be considered used). Please remove all packaging except for toothbrushes and soap. All kits are carefully planned to make them usable in the greatest number of situations. Since strict rules often govern product entry into other countries, it is important that kits contain these exact items:

- Combs (any size or shape, including picks and pocket combs)
- Metal nail files or toenail clippers (no emery boards)
- Bath-size soaps (2.5 oz. and larger; no lvory, Jergens or Lisa brand soaps)
- Toothbrushes (adult size; ensure packaging is completely sealed)
- Adhesive bandages (6 3/4" to 1" width; Band Aid brand preferred)
- Gallon-size reclosable plastic bags (Ziploc-style)
