

#### Psalm 139

# 1. No matter where you go, you are already known and loved by God. (Psalm 139:1-6)

You have brains in your head.
You have feet in your shoes.
You can steer yourself any direction you choose.
You're on your own. And you know what you know.
And YOU are the guy who'll decide where to go.

#### 2. No matter where you go, God is already there. (Psalm 139:7-12)
