

TEACHING NOTES

"Water from a Rock"

Exodus 17:1-7

Scene 1: God led Israel to a campsite with no water.

From the wilderness of Sin the whole congregation of the Israelites journeyed by stages, **as the Lord commanded**. They camped at Rephidim, but there was no water for the people to drink.

Exodus 17:1

Scene 2: God's people argue with and test the Lord.

Exodus 17:2-3

² The people quarreled with Moses and said, "Give us water to drink." Moses said to them, "Why do you quarrel with me? **Why do you test the Lord**?" ³ But the people thirsted there for water, and the people complained against Moses and said, "Why did you bring us out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and livestock with thirst?"

⁴ So Moses cried out to the Lord, "What shall I do for this people? They are almost ready to stone me." ⁵ The Lord said to Moses, "Go on ahead of the people and take some of the elders of Israel with you; take in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile and go. ⁶ I will be standing there in front of you on the rock at Horeb. Strike the rock, and water will come out of it, so that the people may drink." Moses did so, in the sight of the elders of Israel.

Exodus 17:4-6

¹³ Jesus said to her, "Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, ¹⁴ but **those who drink of the water that I will give them will never be thirsty**. The water that I will give will become in them a spring of water gushing up to eternal life."

John 4:13-14

Scene 4: Moses commemorates their failure to trust God.

⁷He called the place *Massah and Meribah*, because the Israelites quarreled and tested the Lord, saying, "Is the Lord among us or not?"

Exodus 17:7

⁶ O come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker! ⁷ For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture and the sheep of his hand. O that today you would listen to his voice! ⁸ Do not harden your hearts, as at **Meribah**, as on the day at **Massah** in the wilderness, ⁹ when your ancestors tested me and put me to the proof, though they had seen my work.


