

#### **TEACHING NOTES**

#### "Manna from Heaven"

Exodus 16:2-15

Manna from Heaven: God will provide **everything** we need.

When the Israelites saw it, they said to one another, "**What is it**?" For they did not know what it was. Moses said to them, "It is the bread that the Lord has given you to eat.

**Exodus 16:15** 

Then the Lord said to Moses, "I am going to rain bread from heaven for you, and **each day** the people shall go out and gather **enough for that day**..."

Exodus 16:4

He humbled you by letting you hunger, then by feeding you with manna, with which neither you nor your ancestors were acquainted, in order to make you understand that **one does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of the Lord**.

Deuteronomy 8:3

For the bread of God is that which comes down from heaven and **gives life to the world**."

John 6:33

Manna from Heaven:

God is concerned for **everyone** in the community.

<sup>9</sup> Then Moses said to Aaron, "Say to **the whole congregation of the Israelites**, 'Draw near to the Lord, for he has heard your complaining." <sup>10</sup> And as Aaron spoke to **the whole congregation of the Israelites**, they looked toward the wilderness, and the glory of the Lord appeared in the cloud.

#### Manna from Heaven God commands us to observe the Sabbath **every week**.

On the sixth day, when they prepare what they bring in, it will be **twice as much as they gather on other days**.

Exodus 16:5

For in six days **the Lord** made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but **rested the seventh day**; therefore, the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and consecrated it.

Exodus 20:11

Remember that **you were a slave** in the land of Egypt, and **the Lord your God brought you out** from there with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm; therefore, the Lord your God commanded you to keep the Sabbath day.
