

TEACHING NOTES

When Moses Prays: Experiencing Awe and Intimacy with God

Exodus 33:12-23

Thus the Lord used to speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend.

Exodus 33:11

1. Moses prays because he is desperate for the presence of God.

12 Moses said to the Lord, "See, you have said to me, Bring up this people,' but you have not let me know whom you will send with me. Yet you have said, I know you by name, and you have also found favor in my sight.' 13 Now if I have found favor in your sight, please show me your ways, so that I may know you and find favor in your sight. Consider, too, that this nation is your people."

Exodus 33:12-13

As a deer longs for flowing streams, so my soul longs for you, O God.

Psalm 42:1

He said, "My presence will go with you, and I will give you rest."

Exodus 33:14

2. Moses prays with confidence in the faithfulness of God.

¹⁵ And he said to him, "If your presence will not go, do not bring us up from here. ¹⁶ For how shall it be known that I have found favor in your sight, I and your people, unless you go with us? In this way, we shall be distinct, I and your people, from every people on the face of the earth."
