

TEACHING NOTES

"Laws Etched in Stone" Exodus 20:1-4, 7-9, 12-20



1. Grace comes first, then obedience.

² "I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery; ³ you shall have no other gods before me."

Exodus 20:2-3

2. The purpose of the Law is relationships.

"I will take you as my people, and I will be your God. You shall know that I am the Lord your God, who has freed you from the burdens of the Egyptians."

Exodus 6:7

¹² "Honor your father and your mother, so that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.

¹³ "You shall not murder.

¹⁴ "You shall not commit adultery.

¹⁵ "You shall not steal.

¹⁶ "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

¹⁷ "You shall not covet your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, male or female slave, ox, donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor."
