## **TEACHING NOTES**

"An Easter of My Own"
John 20:1-18



Listen! I am standing at the door, knocking; if you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in and eat with you, and you with me.

Revelation 3:20

1. For **Simon Peter**, Easter opens the door to **a new beginning**.

<sup>6</sup> Then Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the tomb. He saw the linen wrappings lying there, <sup>7</sup> and the cloth that had been on Jesus's head, not lying with the linen wrappings but rolled up in a place by itself.

John 20:6-7

Immediately the rooster crowed the second time. Then Peter remembered the word Jesus had spoken to him: "Before the rooster crows twice you will disown me three times." And he broke down and wept.

Mark 14:72

#### 2. For John, Easter opens the door to a new answer to life's most important question.
